# 1. CALL TO ORDER:

### 3. ADOPTION OF THE MINUTES:

# 4. **CORRESPONDENCE:**

4.1 The committee received a letter from the Coldwater Steampunk Festival requesting that the Township of Tay consider becoming a Community Sponsor by donating between \$500.00 to \$2,000.00 to this youth-inspired family friendly arts & culture event.

This item was referred for discussion during item 5.4.

# 5. <u>NEW & UNFINISHED BUSINESS:</u>

- 5.1 The Director of Finance provided an overview of the Terms of Reference and the role of the Grants Committee.
- The Director of Finance advised that in accordance with the Terms of Reference the committee shall meet at least quarterly.
   It was agreed that the committee meet June 28<sup>th</sup>, September 27<sup>th</sup> and December 20<sup>th</sup>, 2017 with a start time of 11:00 a.m.

5.3 The Director of Finance spoke to the Township's Grant and Donations Policy and made reference to the different policies of neighbouring municipalities.

Moved by: Councillor Crawford Seconded by: Councillor LaChapelle

That the Director of Finance provide a 1<sup>st</sup> draft Donation Policy to include that an annual financial statement be submitted by the group or organization.

And further that it include a criteria that the group or organization must provide a benefit to local residents.

Carried.

5.4 The Director of Finance outlined the 2017 Grants and Donations Summary and a lengthy discussion ensued with respect to the nature of donations for consideration.

That the following Grants be approved:

- Victoria Harbour Canada Day Celebration \$1,300
- Portarama Celebration \$1,300
- Waubaushene Santa Clause Parade \$1,300
- Lion's Club grant for taxation costs for Lion's Club building on Port McNicoll Community Center property -\$2,785
- Graduation Awards \$700
- Remembrance Day Legion donations \$300
- Port McNicoll Cemetery grant for cost of Insurance -\$1,072
- Post-Secondary Education Bursary Program in partnership with the County of Simcoe - \$1,000 Carried.

It was noted that the following Grants were previously approved by Council for 2017: Georgian Bay Hospital \$23,000, Port McNicoll 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration \$10,000, Community Reach Transportation Linking Communities \$3,500 and North Simcoe Agricultural Expo Agricole Association (Farm Fresh Food Fest) \$1,500.

A further discussion ensued with respect to donation requests where the festival/activity does not occur within Township boundaries and it was agreed there is no direct benefit to Township residents.

That the following Grants be denied:

- Coldwater & District Agricultural Society for the Coldwater Fair
- Southeast Georgian Bay Chamber of Commerce
- Quest Art School and Gallery
- Coldwater Steampunk Festival

At this point in the meeting the Committee requested that the Director of Finance provide a report outlining the Township facility waived fees policy, the 2016 waived rental fees and a calculation of staff time to prepare and clean the facilities for a rental.
